Goal: Reduce invasive species infestation to less than 5%.

Summary from 2009 -2024 reviewed from Power Point.

Most all of our delineated and requested acres continue to be approved for treatment.

EWM graphs.

CLP treatment was completed in May 2024, and 78.4 acres were treated.

EWM Treatment:

- -East Basin 0 acres identified
- -West Basin 22.1 acres identified so far, but not treated.

Water clarity is better

CLID has applied for an Anoka County grant for AIS reimbursement for 2024 CLID was NOT awarded a DNR grant this year. DNR ran out of money for Grants.

Slide 12 and 13. Proposed Lake Treatment Plan and Cost for 2025

Continue early spring CLP treatment as necessary. Continue EWM spot treatment in East and West Basins. Permit application by January 2025

April or early May CLP treatment, 100 acres @ \$200/acre = \$20,000. EWM treatment, 100 acres @ \$726/acre = \$72,600

New Transect survey or AIS delineation \$5,000

TOTAL: \$97,600

Al Beck moved to approve \$92,600 for treatment of Eurasian Water Milfoil, Hybrid EWM and Curly Leaf Pondweed in 2025 as part of the Lake Vegetation Management Plan to control invasive species. Motion made by Jeff Welciek and seconded by Chris Larson. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion for Special Tax Assessment

Al Beck moved to approve an Assessment of \$100 for the current property owners of record. Motion made by Mike Bury and seconded by Ron Croteau. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion for the 2025 Proposed Expenses

Al Beck moved to approve 2025 expenses of \$105,500 including administration potential expenses. Motion made by Jeff Welciek and seconded by Chris Larson. Motion passed unanimously.
